

Tammy and I would like to thank you for your prayers and support! We know that without you we would not be able to do the work that the Lord has for us to do.

Keeping Busy - Since the first of the year, we have been back on the road. It feels great, however, sometimes it is still very painful. In between reporting to churches and raising new support, we have been helping in a new church plant in Polk, OH. A year and a half ago, Hershel and Juanita Case started Temple Baptist Church. Brother Hershel went home to be with the Lord in January, which has left a new church without a pastor. Most of the people that attend are new believers, so we have been visiting and preaching at the church until god brings someone along. Please be in prayer for these dear folks.

Armenia - By the time you receive this letter, Tammy and I will be in Armenia. I will be teaching and preparing a group of men that will be starting a new church plant in June. Tammy will be teaching some ladies classes while we are there. We will be there for National Women's Day and there will be special services at the church. We will also be working on setting up the ground work for a Bible translation project, as well as doing some evangelistic outreach. We are very excited to see what the Lord has in store for us on this trip. Armenia has great potential to reach the people of the closed countries around them. They are permitted to travel in and out of these countries. People from the surrounding closed countries are permitted to travel in and out of Armenia. The possibilities are endless!! As they train men from the closed countries to reach their own people, the will also teach them of their responsibilities to reach even further to their neighbors. Please pray for God's direction for us and for them.

Meetings - I have a lot of open dates from April until our next trip to India in November. I am asking if pastors can help me fill these dates. If you know of a church in your area that you could contact on my behalf, or that I could contact, that would be interested in having us come in and present the ministry of the Unreached in the 10/40 window, please let me know. I have been on the phone constantly, but have been having no success in getting meetings.

Finances - Please also be in prayer for our finances. We are still trying to get back on track after the accident. The accident was not my fault, but the insurance is still giving us problems with paying for the expenses, especially the medical bills. We also need to replace our truck that was totaled in the accident. It is what we used to pull our 5th wheel camper that has not sold yet. We know that God has a plan and are trying to be patient and wait. Sometimes we aren't completely patient.

Thank you again for your prayers! We feel at peace heading to Armenia knowing that all of you will be praying for us.
